DESCRIPTION:

The wines of Tenuta Valdipiatta are obtained exclusively from grapes grown in its own vineyards, which extend for approximately 30 hectares over the hills in the municipality of Montepulciano. Of the vineyards, 80% is dedicated to the cultivation of Sangiovese, the traditional Tuscan variety, which in Montepulciano takes the local name of "Prugnolo Gentile". Canaiolo Nero and Mammolo complete the range of typical grapes of the area, whereas Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Pinot Nero provide the basis for the Typical Geographical designated wines, which are produced side by side with the traditional production of Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Rosso di Montepulciano and Chianti. All the vineyards were renewed at the beginning of the 90's.

TASTING NOTES:

"The 2013 Vino Nobile di Montepulciano hits the palate with serious intensity and overall depth. Succulent red cherry, plum, smoke, licorice, herb, tobacco and incense meld together in a pliant, highly expressive Vino Nobile that hits all the right notes. Firm tannins and bright acidity suggest the 2013 will drink well for a number of years." - November 2016
